 - **£1,500 fund to carry out the programme requirements**

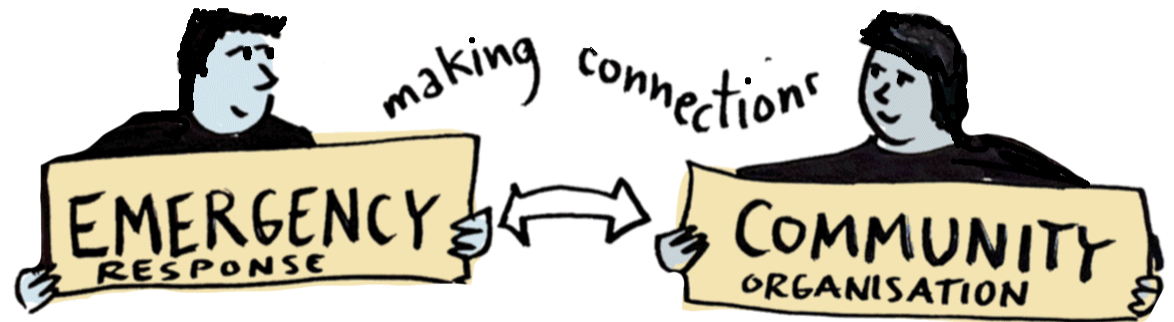
Programme Overview – the requirements
